In particular, note that students are usually 16 turning 17 years in the year they commence Year 11 and cannot be older than 17 years and 6 months when commencing Year 11.

Potential students need to be of an age in line with current Lorien Novalis students, and will not be aged older than 18 at enrolment, and will not have reached the age of 19 by the end of Class 12

Students cannot commence studying at Lorien Novalis School part way through Year 11 or Year 12 unless that student is transferring from another provider in NSW and can continue their courses uninterrupted (see the Lorien Novalis Handbook section on "Transferring from another NSW Provider" for further information).
