### ROLE DESCRIPTION

Position Title: Full-Time Humanities Teacher  
Position Reports to: Head of High School, and ultimately to the Head of School.  
Role Location: Lorien Novalis School for Rudolf Steiner Education, Dural.

- Head of High School and High School teaching staff
- Head of School
- All Staff, whole school community (staff, parents, students, interested and active parties)

### About the position

The position is a full-time position and the successful applicant would be actively involved in extra-curricular activities. The position has the potential to include Class Guardianship in the future. The position would include:

- History (Stages 4 & 5)

Combined with one or more of the following:

- Philosophy (Stage 6 a Board Endorsed Course)
- Aboriginal Studies (Stage 6)
- Earth & Environment (Stage 6)
- English (Stages 4 & 5)

The position involves both Main Lessons, as well as Middle and Afternoon Lessons, and would include some practical lessons.

The position would commence mid-January 2020. (If preferred by the successful applicant, there is the possibility of commencing part-time in Term 4 of 2019, employment dates for Term 4 would be at a mutually agreeable arrangement).

## Teacher Required Qualifications

- Accreditation to teach with the New South Wales Educational Standards Association (NESA).
- Subject specific qualifications to teach History plus one or more of the subjects as listed under "About the Position".
- Current Working with Children Check

## Selection Criteria

1. Clearly state the two or more subjects listed under "About the Position" you are applying to teach, and clearly indicate that you are qualified to teach those subjects, and familiar with the specific NESA curriculum (if listing Philosophy – there is no curriculum requirements you need to address in your application);
2. A love for working with high school students, and a willingness to be open to anthroposophy and to develop teaching methods in line with Rudolf Steiner education;
3. The ability to follow lesson outlines to deliver engaging and developmentally appropriate science curriculum for students in mixed-ability classrooms;
4. A genuine enthusiasm for teaching humanities to high school;
5. An ability to work collegially and a commitment to extra-curricular activities such as staff meetings, staff development activities, Spring Fair, Open Day, Major Works presentations, and class trips; and
6. Excellent organisational skills; as well as the ability to follow procedures; as well as excellent computer skills and the ability to use (or the ability to efficiently learn how to use) Program Builder and Edumate;
7. Give a statement about your interest and/or experience in a Steiner High School Educational setting.
8. Briefly list any artistic, craft, sporting, technical or other skills or interests.
