



Part-time Mathematics Teacher (Stages 4, 5 & 6) and/or IT Teacher (Stage 4)

Thank you for your interest in applying for the Part-time Mathematics and/or IT Teacher Position at Lorien Novalis School for Rudolf Steiner Education.

The role could include teaching mathematics from Stage 4 up to Stage 6 Mathematics General 2, and could include teaching IT if suitably qualified; other lessons could be included as timetabled.

The position is predominantly for teaching on either Mondays & Tuesdays, or Wednesday & Thursdays, (there could be a possibility of ½ day Friday, but this is not essential).

The position can be negotiated to be a 0.3 to 0.5 FTE role, commencing Term 1 2018.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Position title: Part-time Mathematics (& possibly I.T.) high school Teacher

Teacher Required Qualifications

- The applicant is required to hold relevant teaching qualifications and experience as required for accreditation with the New South Wales Educational Standards Association (NESA).
- Subject specific qualifications to teach Mathematics; optionally to also be able to teach Stage 4 Information Technology (T.A.S.).
- Appointment will be subject to a satisfactory Working with Children Check as required under the Child Protection (Working With Children) Act 2012.

Selection Criteria

1. A willingness to be open to anthroposophy and to develop teaching methods in line with Rudolf Steiner education;
2. A genuine enthusiasm for teaching mathematics (and optionally, IT), and for working with high school students;
3. The ability to follow lesson outlines to deliver an engaging and developmentally appropriate mathematics curriculum for high school students;
4. An ability to work collegially;
5. Excellent organisational skills and the ability to follow procedures; and
6. Excellent computer skills and the ability to use (or the ability to efficiently learn how to use) Program Builder and Edumate.
7. *Not essential:* List any artistic, craft, sporting, technical or other skills or interests, and list any experience in a Rudolf Steiner school.

NOTE: Recently graduated and soon-to-graduate teachers are welcome to apply.
