Summary for Students

This document should be read together with the document: RoSA and HSC Assessment Handbook.

The following summarises what Class 10, 11 and 12 students need to be aware of: Students are to complete and submit all assessment tasks by the due date; and to be present for those assessment tasks held at Lorien Novalis School.

Students who are unable to attend Lorien Novalis School on the day of an assessment task, are to phone Lorien Novalis School and explain their absence.

Students who fail to submit an assessment task by the due date and who have not completed an Assessment Appeal Form or do not have appropriate documentation will be penalised.

A student who is absent from an assessment task (test, exam or assignment) is to speak to the Subject Teacher immediately on their return to school and submit an Assessment Appeal Form along with relevant documentation (e.g. hospital paperwork).

If a student is unable to complete an assessment task for reasons of injury, ill-health or misadventure, they will submit an Assessment Appeal Form.

A zero mark will be recorded for any assessment task, which the student misses and for which an acceptable reason is not given. It is the responsibility of the student to consult with the Subject teacher if the student experiences problems in fulfilling the course requirements.

It is the responsibility of the student to consult with their Class Guardian if the student experiences problems in interpreting the RoSA & HSC Assessment Handbook or the Assessment Schedule.

When reading a course assessment schedule, it is important to remember: there is a balance between the assessment of knowledge and understanding outcomes and course content, and skills outcomes and content; a range of assessment tasks are used as outlined in the syllabus; individual tasks are generally worth between 10% and 40% of the total assessment mark; and the types of tasks used for internal assessment are generally broader than those used in the HSC examinations for the course. This gives students the opportunity to demonstrate their achievement of the standards in different ways. A broader range of tasks also allows a wider range of outcomes to be assessed than may be possible in the external examination.

Note that: The same outcomes may be assessed by more than one task. One task can assess more than one component. Tasks are not necessarily of equal weight. To arrive at a student's final assessment mark for a subject the student's marks in each assessment task are combined.
