

Application Pack: Part-time Science Teacher (Stages 4, 5 & 6)

Thank you for your interest in applying for the Part-time Science Teacher Position at Lorien Novalis School for Rudolf Steiner Education.

The position is primarily for teaching Main Lessons, and as such would involve teaching, at the minimum, the first half of each school day. Otherwise, the position is negotiable from 0.5 to 1.0 FTE role. If the position commenced part-time, it has the possibility of developing into a full-time position. The position would commence within Term 2, 2018, at a date mutually agreeable.

How to Apply

1. A resume (max. 2 pages), providing a brief summary of your career, outlining relevant positions you have held and major responsibilities; as well as the names, positions and telephone contact numbers for at least two referees who can comment on your suitability for the position.
2. Concisely, but fully, address each of the selection criteria. Number each selection criteria.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Position title: Part-time Science high school Teacher

Teacher Required Qualifications

- The applicant is required to hold relevant teaching qualifications and experience as required for accreditation with the New South Wales Educational Standards Association (NESA).
- Subject specific qualifications to teach from Stage 4 and Stage 5 Science, with studies in both chemistry and physics.
- Appointment will be subject to a satisfactory Working with Children Check as required under the Child Protection (Working With Children) Act 2012.

Selection Criteria

1. A love for working with high school students, and a willingness to be open to anthroposophy and to develop teaching methods in line with Rudolf Steiner education;
2. The ability to follow lesson outlines to deliver an engaging and developmentally appropriate science curriculum for students in a mixed-ability classroom for Stages 4 and 5;
3. A genuine enthusiasm for teaching chemistry and physics; and a willingness to teach children at Stage 3;
4. An ability to work collegially and a commitment to regularly attend staff meetings; and
5. Excellent organisational skills; as well as the ability to follow procedures; as well as excellent computer skills and the ability to use (or the ability to efficiently learn how to use) Program Builder and Edumate;
6. Preferable (but not essential): experience in a Steiner High School Educational setting.
7. Preferable (but not essential): applicants are invited to state any academic and/or practical experience or study in the area of Marine Studies.
8. Preferable (but not essential): Applicants are invited to briefly list any artistic, craft, sporting, technical or other skills or interests.

NOTE: Recently graduated teachers are welcome to apply, also science degree graduates who have commenced their teaching qualifications are welcome to apply.
